Hazzard	1 Piobaireachd: nice and easy. Description: Piobaireachd compositions which are relatively easy and accessible don't have to be boring – we will review a few truly beautiful and melodic tunes, suitable for beginner piobaireachd players. Target: Beginner/novice.  2 Performance preparation and presentation – what your teacher never told you. Description: How you prepare for a competition or performance – and how you present yourself on the day – can make all the difference. But, these aspects are often overlooked in traditional piping lessons. This will provide some great hints and strategies for ensuring you look, feel and sound prepared, polished and confident. Target: Anyone but probably most suited for ~gr.5 to gr.2 amateur.  3 Dancing feet: strathspeys, reels and jigs.
